Like everyone else, we face financial challenges. This year we aim to grow our revenue in ways begun last year. Our Events Team is continuing to bring in money to support our church and to improve our impact in the local community. The friendly Team needs more volunteers to progress these aims.

Most of our income is spent on ministry, including the Parish Share (which we must pay to the diocese for maintaining Christian ministry in this parish, and supporting the training of new clergy and clergy pensions), as well as running and staffing our own Parish Office. Heating, lighting and insurance total well over £20,000 a year.
